

LIST OF ITEMS NEED TO OBTAIN DRIVING PERMIT AT DEPARTMENT OF PUBLIC SAFETY (DPS)

1. **FORM PPD-043 (VOE)** Verification of Enrollment and Attendance, this form can be obtained from the registrar at your high school. Home School students must fill out the home school affidavit.
 2. **BIRTH CERTIFICATE:** This must be a certificate copy, with a seal. They will **NOT** accept a hospital issue or photocopy.
 3. **SOCIAL SECURITY CARD** – They Will **NOT** accept a photocopy.
 4. **FEE.** For Driving Permit is \$16.00 (\$25.00 if you are 18 or over).
 5. **DE-964** – Texas Driver Education Certificate (For teenagers issued on or after 3rd day of class)
 6. **FORM DL-14A** – Application for Texas Driver’s License (DO NOT sign, put your SSN or put the Date until present with a DPS representative or a notary)
 7. **FORM DL-40** – Additional DPS form (DO NOT sign this until present with a DPS representative or a notary)
 8. **TWO PROOFS OF RESIDENCY** for the state of Texas.
 9. **PARENT / LEGAL GUARDIAN** (Applicant under 18)
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ACCEPTABLE DOCUMENTS THAT PROVE RESIDENCY

These documents prove residency for a non-commercial driver license or ID card.

Current deed, mortgage, monthly mortgage statement, mortgage payment booklet or a residential rental/lease agreement.	Utility statement (including electric, water, natural gas, satellite TV, cable TV or non-cellular phone bill) dated within 90 days of the day of application.
Valid, unexpired Texas voter registration card.	Texas concealed handgun license.
Texas motor vehicle registration or title.	Texas boat registration or title.
Selective service card.	Medical or health card.
Current homeowner's or renter's insurance policy or homeowner or renter's insurance statement.	Current automobile insurance policy or an automobile insurance statement.
Texas high school, college, or university report card or transcript for the current school year.	Preprinted paycheck or payment stub dated within 90 days of the application.
Current Form DS2019, I-20, or a document issued by U.S. Citizenship and Immigration Services.	Document from the Texas Department of Criminal Justice indicating the applicants release or parole.
Current automobile payment booklet.	W-2 or 1099 tax form from the current tax year.
Current documents issued by the U.S. Military indicating residence address.	Mail from a federal, state, country, or city government agency dated within 90 days of the date of application.
Checking or savings account statements dated within 90 days of the date of application.	Credit card or investment account statements dated within 90 days of the date of application.
